- Handicap Limit: 36 (Boys), 45 (Girls)
 - Trophies will be awarded to the Overall Gross Winner and Runner Up, and the Overall Nett Winner and Runner Up in each event
 - Nearest to the Pin on Par 3 holes (boys and girls)
 - Tee times will commence from 9:00am – The draw will be available at www.bdga.com.au from Saturday 19th January
 - The entry fee for 18 hole events is \$25, which includes a BBQ lunch and drink

The following events will be played over 9 holes of stroke play:

5. Under 14 Boys
 6. Under 14 Girls
 7. Primary School Boys
 8. Primary School Girls
- No handicap is required for these events
 - Trophies will be awarded to the Overall Gross Winner and Runner Up in each event
 - Tee times will commence from 10:00am – The draw will be available at www.bdga.com.au from Monday 19th January
 - The entry fee for 9 hole events is \$15, which includes a BBQ lunch and drink

2019 JUNIOR CLASSIC – TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

- 1. AGE ELIGIBILITY:** Players under the age of 18 as at 21st January 2019. Players who attended primary school in 2018 are eligible to play in the primary school events.
- 2. TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE:** The Ballarat District Golf Incorporated – Junior Development Sub-Committee shall have the entire management responsibility for the tournament, including the authority to alter a player's handicap in accordance with the Australian Handicapping System.
- 3. NUMBER OF ENTRIES:** The Tournament Committee shall have the authority to limit the number of entries accepted.
- 4. TEE TIMES:** Players must report to the starter 15 minutes prior to their tee time and be prepared to hit off when called upon. Tee times will be available at www.bdga.com.au from Saturday 19th January.
- 5. ENTRIES:** Entries into events 1, 2, 3 and 4 are restricted to amateurs who are current members of clubs affiliated with Golf Victoria or of golf clubs affiliated with the Victorian Golf League. The Tournament Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 6. RULES:** The tournament shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, together with such local rules that are in force at the time of the tournament. Disputes shall be decided by the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final. However if the Tournament Committee is in doubt, it reserves the right to refer a dispute to Golf Victoria, whose decision shall be final. Any such dispute must be made in writing to the Tournament Committee no later than 15 minutes after the completion of play.
- 7. TROPHIES:** No player is eligible to win more than one trophy in the tournament. This excludes Nearest to the Pins. Note: A minimum of five players will be required for trophies to be awarded for a specific age/gender group. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to redefine age/gender groups should insufficient entries be received.
- 8. TIES:** In the event of a tie, the winner shall be determined on count-back, under the system recommended by Golf Australia.
- 9. HANDICAP CHANGES:** All entrants into events 1, 2, 3 and 4 must use their current handicap and make any alterations on the scorecard, if their handicap has changed from that shown on their entry form.
- 10. WEATHER PROVISION:** The Tournament Committee may in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason either shorten the competition or postpone it to another day.
- 11. DRESS CODE:** All players will be made honorary members of the Midlands Golf Club for the duration of the tournament. Dress standards will apply to all players and spectators whilst on the course or in the clubhouse.
- 12. DATABASE OF PLAYER DETAILS:** The data contained on an entry form submitted by a player for the Open Junior Championships is retained by Ballarat District Golf Incorporated within its database. This database is operated to assist with the management of current and future Ballarat District Golf Incorporated events. From time to time players may be sent entry forms or event literature. Upon receipt of a written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.
