

14. **Slow Play:** A member appointed by the host club or a member or appointee of the B.D.G.A. shall have the power to take action to deal with slow play.
15. **Points to be awarded for percentage:**
1up-1, 2up-2, 2/1-3, 3/1-4, 3/2-5, 4/2-6, 4/3-7, 5/3-8, 5/4-9, 6/4-10, 6/5-11, 7/5-12, 7/6-13, 8/6-14, 8/7-15, 9/7-16, 9/8-17, 10/8-18
16. The Host club is responsible for ensuring that the result sheets are lodged with the District secretary, on the Sunday evening after the conclusion of the Pennant.
17. **Finals:** In each division the 2 teams with the highest number of points, will play off in a final. Should 2 teams be tied for a berth in the final, individual matches will be taken into account to decide the finalist.
18. Any Player late for Tee-Off will forfeit each Hole until he/she catches the Group.
19. Present Players are entitled to give five (5) minutes grace before hitting off.
20. Remember: Your place in the Field is right in front of the group in front; not in front of the Group behind.

Rules & Regulations

1. The number of teams in a Division is to be 4 or 6. Teams shall consist of 5 players.
2. Eligibility: To be eligible to compete in the Charleson / Hunt Pennant competition, a player must be a financial member of the club he represents. Honorary and non-playing members are not eligible to represent their clubs.
3. Clubs entering teams must be affiliated and financial with the B.D.G at the commencement of this Pennant Competition.
4. Individual matches are to be played in reverse order 5 to 1, with the Charleson division being straight matchplay (no strokes given), while the Hunt division will be handicap matchplay (max 27) - players are to give or receive strokes according to the difference in handicaps e.g. Player A has a handicap of 12, Player B has a handicap of 18, Player A has to give Player B a shot on the 6 hardest holes as per the Standard stroke Index as indicated on the course score card. Players in the Hunt division are to be listed in handicap order on the team sheet with Player #1 – lowest h'cap, Player #5 – highest h'cap. Handicaps used are to be those as shown on Golfink at the start of play.
5. No player of a participating team shall act as a caddie for another player during a contest, nor is it permitted for anyone who has caddied for a player during a contest, to caddie for another player during that same contest.
6. Matches which are even after the completion of 18 holes, will be recorded as halves, except in the finals where each match shall be played until a result is achieved. If an individual match is not completed, it shall not be taken into account when assessing either team's performance prior to the finals. Walkovers will be recorded as 10 & 8 losses.
7. Clause deleted in 2016
8. Hit off time in all home rounds will be 8:00 a.m. and 1:00p.m using a shotgun start (holes to be determined based on the course being played), unless otherwise decided by those responsible for conducting the competition.
9. Contests shall begin promptly on time as prescribed. Team captains must have their team sheets completed for the starter, 15 minutes before hit off time. Should all players not be present by hit off time, those not present shall forfeit their matches and the team captain shall change the team sheet, so as to ensure that walkovers start at number 5.
10. No contest shall be postponed. In adverse conditions the host club has sole right to close it's course for the day and all matches will be deemed to be halved. Should the course be deemed fit for play, all clubs and their players are expected to play.
11. Host clubs have the right to determine what practice conditions will be available to the players, prior to the start of the competition.
12. A player must play at least 1 game during that season to be eligible to play in the finals.
13. Once a player has played 2 matches in the Charleson competition he then becomes ineligible to play in the Hunt competition in that season. Should a club have more than one team in either the Charleson or Hunt competitions, each team will be treated as separate clubs and no interchange of players will be allowed.
