## COMPETITION FORMAT

- Each week an 18-hole Stableford competition will be conducted at the Midlands Golf Club
- Players can play a minimum of three rounds and a maximum of five rounds in the competition
- At the conclusion of the competition, the top three Stableford scores for each player will be added together to determine the final placings
- Handicap limits: 36 for boys, 45 for girls
- Tee Times will be available between 8:00am and 8:30am each week
- Competition entry fee: \$40

## PRIZES

Great prizes will be presented to the players finishing first, second and third at the conclusion of the competition.

## 2020 SPRING JUNIOR SERIES – COMPETITION CONDITIONS

- 1. AGE ELIGIBILITY:** Players under the age of 18 as at Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2020.
- 2. COMPETITION COMMITTEE:** Michael Cooke from the Midlands Golf Club and members of the Ballarat District Golf – Junior Development Committee shall have the entire management responsibility for the competition.
- 3. COMPETITION FORMAT:** Five 18-hole rounds of Stableford will be conducted. Players will be required to play a minimum of three rounds and can play up to five rounds in the competition. At the conclusion of the competition, the top three Stableford scores for each player will be added together to determine the final placings. This is a mixed gender competition, open to juniors with a Golf Australia handicap – Handicap limits: 36 for boys, 45 for girls.
- 4. ENTRIES:** Entries are restricted to amateurs who are current members of clubs affiliated with Golf Australia or of golf clubs affiliated with the Victorian Golf League. The Competition Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 5. NUMBER OF ENTRIES:** The Competition Committee shall have the authority to limit the number of entries accepted.
- 6. TEE TIMES:** Players must report to the starter 15 minutes prior to their tee time and be prepared to hit off when called upon. Players will be required to book a tee time for each week of the competition by phoning Michael Cooke on 5332 6965 a minimum of 48 hours prior to the day in which they intend to play.
- 7. RULES:** The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, together with such local rules that are in force at the time of the competition. Disputes shall be decided by the Competition Committee, whose decision shall be final. However, if the Competition Committee is in doubt, it reserves the right to refer a dispute to Golf Australia, whose decision shall be final. Any such dispute must be made in writing to the Competition Committee no later than 15 minutes after the completion of play.
- 8. CADDIES:** All players must transport their own clubs unless special arrangements have been made with the Competition Committee.
- 9. PRIZES:** Prizes will be presented to the players finishing first, second and third at the conclusion of the competition. Note: A minimum of ten entries will be required for three prizes to be presented.
- 10. TIES:** In the event of a tie, final placings shall be determined on count-back, under the system recommended by Golf Australia.
- 11. WEATHER PROVISION:** The Competition Committee may in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason either shorten the competition or postpone it to another day.
- 12. DRESS CODE:** All players will be made honorary members of the Midlands Golf Club for the duration of the competition. Dress standards will apply to all players and spectators whilst on the course or in the clubhouse.
- 13. DATABASE OF PLAYER DETAILS:** The data contained on an entry form submitted by a player for the Spring Junior Series is retained by Ballarat District Golf within its database. This database is operated to assist with the management of current and future Ballarat District Golf events. From time to time players may be sent entry forms or event literature. Upon receipt of a written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.
